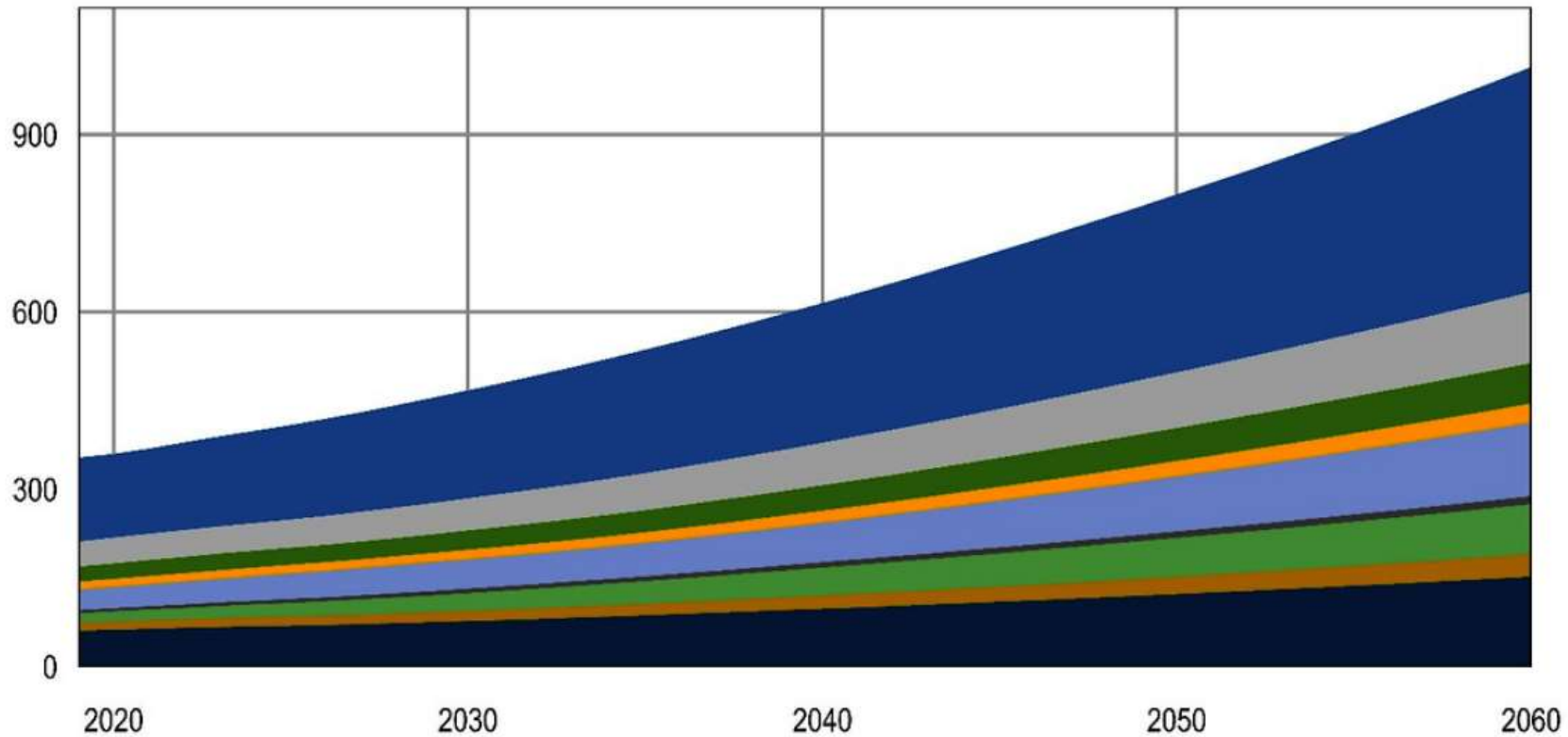
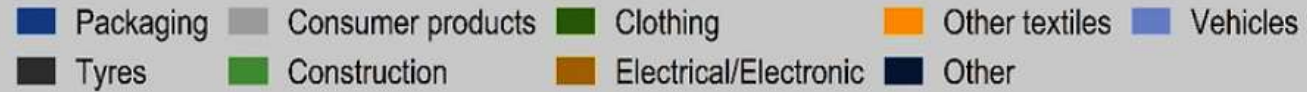
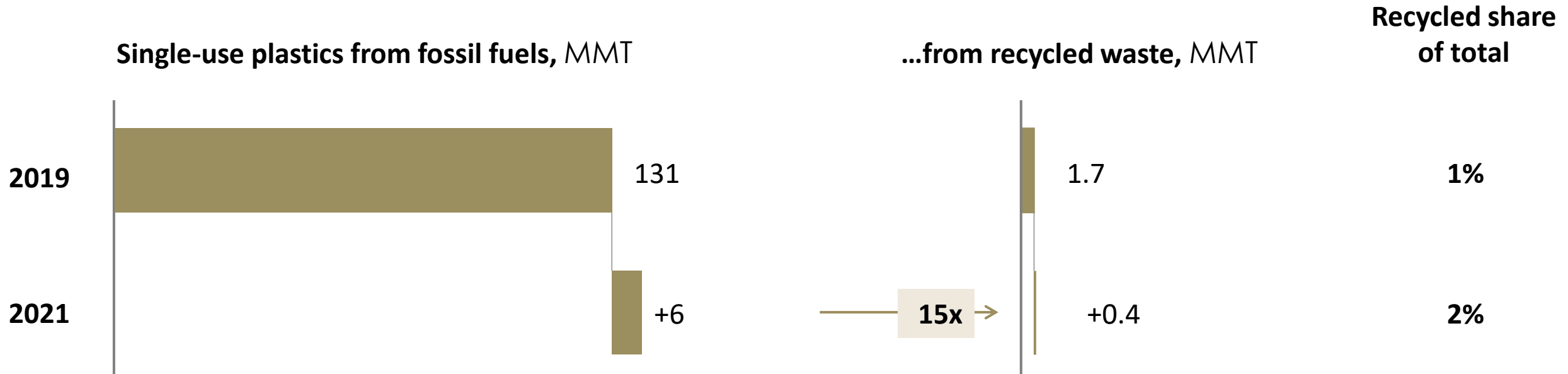

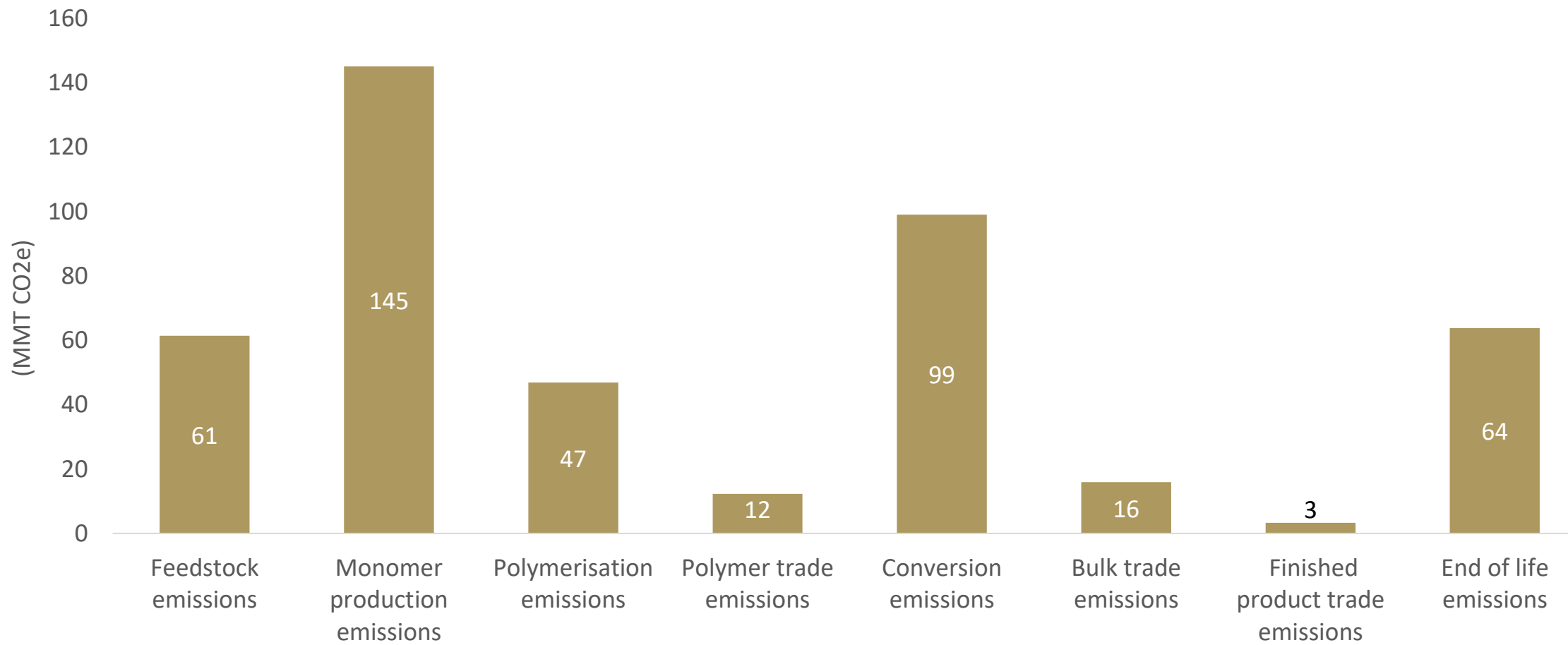
Plastic waste by application in million tonnes (Mt), *Baseline scenario*

- Harms to human health and the environment – at every stage of the plastic life cycle
- The **thousands of chemicals in plastics** are responsible for many of plastics' known harms
- **Plastic is not cheap**: the economic costs of plastics' harms are high and are externalised
- The harms caused by plastics **disproportionately affect vulnerable and at-risk populations**
